Deputy Commanding General – Operations
101st Airborne Division (Air Assault)
Fort Campbell, Kentucky



Brigadier General Travis L. McIntosh (US Army), of Chuckey, Tennessee, currently serves as the Deputy Commanding General for Operations of the 101st Airborne Division (Air Assault) at Fort Campbell, Kentucky.

He most recently served as the Chief of Aviation Force Development at Headquarters Department of the Army, G8 in the Pentagon. A high school valedictorian, West Point graduate, and the top graduate of his flight school class, BG McIntosh has led a very distinguished career of 27 years, commanding at every level from platoon to brigade and within four different infantry divisions.

BG McIntosh served as the brigade commander for the Combat Aviation Brigade of the 10th Mountain Division at Fort Drum, New York and for two years prior served as the lead Theater Campaign Planner at Headquarters, United States European Command in Stuttgart, Germany.

A rotary-wing standardization and instructor pilot with multiple combat tours and over two thousand flight hours, BG McIntosh is a distinguished graduate of the Joint Advanced Warfighting School in Norfolk, VA. He commanded the Assault Helicopter Battalion of the 82nd Airborne Division at Fort Bragg, NC and has served as special advisor to the Army Chief of Staff from 2013-2015. BG McIntosh deployed many times with both the 82nd Airborne and the 101st Airborne Divisions in Operation Enduring Freedom in Afghanistan and Operation Iraqi Freedom in Iraq.

BG McIntosh holds a Bachelor of Science degree from West Point, a Master of Arts in Diplomacy and Military Studies from Hawaii Pacific University, and a Master of Science degree in Joint Campaign Planning and Strategy from National Defense University. He is the recipient of two Legions of Merit, four Bronze Star Medals and three Air Medals for his time in combat; he is a jumpmaster and freefall parachutist with nearly 1000 skydives and 60 military jumps. BG McIntosh and his wife Lisa have been married for 23 years and have two children, Will and Drew.
